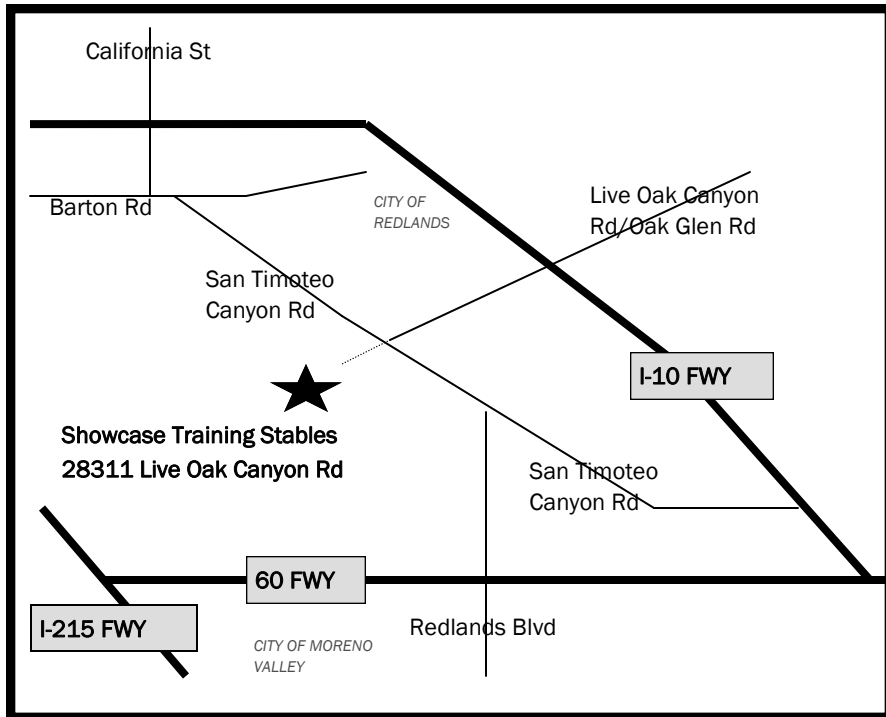

The Show Name registered here is the name that points will accrue on. Please make sure to provide each IEHJA sanctioned show with the correct Show Name. In classes where points accrue for the horse or horse/rider combination, if the wrong Show Name is provided, points will not accrue. Names must remain the same throughout the entire 2011 show season. Horses must be registered to accrue points.

Horse Show Rules and Regulations

Showcase Horse Show Series (SHSS) Management reserves the right to limit or revoke participation at any time to anyone. Riders and/or horses deemed unsafe by SHSS Management will be asked to dismount and leave the ring immediately.

Anyone wishing to ride on the premises on the day of the show must have a completed Release of Liability form on file with the show secretary prior to mounting.

Exhibitors are to compete at their own risk. IEHJA, SHSS, and Showcase Training Stables are not responsible for loss of property or personal injury.

ASTM-SEI approved hard hats with harness and boots are required for anyone on horseback while on show grounds. Proper show attire is required. Black half-chaps are permitted with paddock boots.

Any questions/issues not covered by IEHJA rules will be under the discretion of SHSS management. SHSS Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes at their discretion. A minimum of three entries are required for a class to count for IEHJA points.

Ticketed Warm-Ups must be ridden according to the posted course. A division must fill at 3 Showcase Shows for a SHSS series high point to be awarded. Lunging and warm-ups in designated areas only.

Class Fees will be refunded only if SHSS Management cancels the class, or an official scratch form is filed in the show office before the class starts.

There will be a fee of \$25.00 for all returned checks.

No braiding please. **No stallions.** **PLEASE—NO DOGS!**

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING START TIMES -

Riders **MUST BE READY** for judging when their class is called. Show management will not be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying riders or their agents of class judging. Riders/agents alone are responsible for the presence of their horse in the show ring. Riders must be aware that classes or divisions could be cancelled for a variety of reasons, and this can advance the start times of all subsequent classes and divisions.

Judges need not wait for any rider holding up a class. It should be understood by every rider and trainer that waiting for a rider to enter the ring is a courtesy that may be extended, but that there is no rule or requirement by show management obligating a judge to wait for a rider.

Entry fee(s) will not be refunded in the event the rider is absent, disqualified, or excused from competition.

Class/Division Rules and Regulations

Riders age as of November 1st of previous year.

Schooling is only allowed in classes in which riders are eligible to compete.

Beginner Jumpers: Open to rider and/or horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in jumper classes at any show. Fence height is 2'3". Points to follow horse.

Hopeful Jumpers: Open to riders and/or horses that have not shown in any Jumper class higher than 2'9" in height at any horse show. Fence height is 2'3" to 2'6". Points to follow horse.

Modified Jumpers: Open to all riders and/or horses. Fence height is 2'6" to 2'9". Points to follow the horse.

Cross-Rail Division: Open to Jr./Am riders to jump 18". Riders in Cross-Rails may not cross-enter into any other over fences classes, however may enter into any other flat class .

Walk-Trot Division: Open to Jr./Am riders of all ages. Riders may not enter into any other divisions. Once a rider enters into another division he/she may not return to walk-trot.

Green Rider Division: Open to Jr./Am riders to jump fences 2'0". Riders not to have competed in classes with fence heights higher than 2'3".

Short Stirrup Division: Open to riders twelve (12) and under, to jump fences 2'0" – 2'3". Riders not to have competed in classes with fence heights higher than 2'3".

Long Stirrup Division: Open to riders thirteen (13) to seventeen (17) years of age, to jump fences 2'0" – 2'3". Riders not to have competed in classes with fence heights higher than 2'3".

Rusty Stirrup Division: Open to amateur riders eighteen (18) and over, to jump fences 2'0" – 2'3". Riders not to have competed in classes with fence heights higher than 2'3".

Low Jr./Am Rider Division: Open to Jr./Am riders. Fence height 2'6"

Jr./Am Rider Division: Open to Jr./Am riders. Fence height 2'9"

Baby Green Hunter Division: Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in the hunter division. Fence height 2'.

Green Hunter Division: Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in the hunter division. Fence height 2'3" to 2'6".

Low Hunter Division: Open to horses and/or riders of any hunter level. Fence height 2'3" to 2'6".

Modified Hunter Division: Open to horses and/or riders of any hunter level. Fence height 2'6 to 2'9"

Medal classes

IEHJA Mini Medal: Open to all Jr./Am riders who have not competed over fences higher than 2'3".

IEHJA Flat Medal: Open to all Jr./Am riders.

IEHJA Medal: Open to all Jr./Am riders who have not competed over fences 2'6"& higher. Cross entries are not permitted between the IEHJA Mini Medal and the IEHJA Medal.
