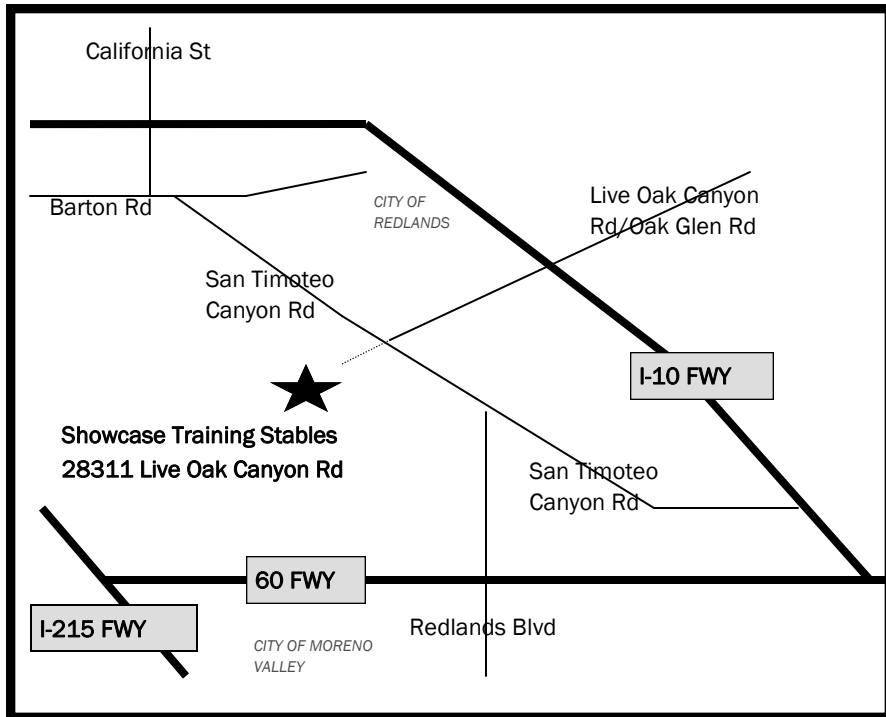

Horse Show Rules and Regulations

- Showcase Horse Show Series (SHSS) Management reserves the right to limit or revoke participation at any time to anyone. Riders and/or horses deemed unsafe by SHSS Management will be asked to dismount and leave the ring immediately.
- Anyone wishing to ride on the premises on the day of the show must have a completed Release of Liability form on file with the show secretary prior to mounting.
- Exhibitors are to compete at their own risk. IEHJA, SHSS, and Showcase Training Stables are not responsible for loss of property or personal injury.
- ASTM-SEI approved hard hats with harness and boots are required for anyone on horseback while on show grounds. Proper show attire is required. Black half-chaps are permitted with paddock boots.
- Any questions/issues not covered by IEHJA rules will be under the discretion of SHSS management. SHSS Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes at their discretion. A minimum of three entries are required for a class to run.
- Ticketed Warm-Ups must be ridden according to the posted course.
- A division must fill at 3 Showcase Shows for a SHSS series high point to be awarded.
- Lunging and warm-ups in designated areas only.
- Class Fees will be refunded only if SHSS Management cancels the class, or an official scratch form is filed in the show office before the class starts.
- There will be a fee of \$25.00 for all returned checks.
- No braiding please. **No stallions.** PLEASE—NO DOGS!

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING START TIMES -

Riders MUST BE READY for judging when their class is called. Show management will not be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying riders or their agents of class judging. Riders/agents alone are responsible for the presence of their horse in the show ring. Riders must be aware that classes or divisions could be cancelled for a variety of reasons, and this can advance the start times of all subsequent classes and divisions.

Judges need not wait for any rider holding up a class. It should be understood by every rider and trainer that waiting for a rider to enter the ring is a courtesy that may be extended, but that there is no rule or requirement by show management obligating a judge to wait for a rider.

Entry fee(s) will not be refunded in the event the rider is absent, disqualified, or excused from competition.

Class/Division Rules and Regulations

Riders age as of December 1st of previous year.

Schooling is only allowed in classes in which riders are eligible to compete.

Cross-Rail Division: Open to Jr./Am riders. Fence height 18". Riders may enter any flat class. Riders may trot or canter their fences. Points are based on horse/rider combination. Riders who have competed over fence heights 2' or higher may not compete in this division.

Walk-Trot Division: Open to Jr./Am riders. Once a rider competes in a division with fences over 18", he/she may not return to the walk-trot division. Points are based on horse/rider combination. Riders who have entered into a higher division in previous IEHJA shows or classes may not compete in this division.

Class/Division Rules and Regulations, continued:

Green Rider Division: Open to Jr./Am riders to jump fences 2' with no oxers. Riders may not have competed over fences over 2'3" in height. Riders may cross enter into any division or classes with fence heights of 2'3". Points based on horse/rider combination.

Short Stirrup Division: Open to riders 12 and under. Fence height 2'3" with oxers. Riders not have competed over fences higher than 2'6". Riders may cross over into either Green Rider or Low Jr./Am division, but not both. Riders may not cross enter into any classes with fence heights exceeding 2'6". Points based on horse/rider combination.

Long Stirrup Division: Open to junior riders 13 to 17 years. Rest of rules same as above for Short Stirrup Division.

Rusty Stirrup Division: Open to amateur riders 18 and over. Rest of rules same as above for Short Stirrup Division.

Low Jr./Am Rider Division: Open to Jr./Am riders. Fences 2'6" with oxers. Equitation over fences must have one bending line. Riders may cross enter into either the stirrup division or the Jr./AM division but not both. Riders may not cross enter into Green Rider Division or the IEHJA 2'3" Medal. Points follow horse/rider combination.

Jr./Am Equitation Division: Open to Jr./AM riders. Fences 2'6" with oxers. One round must include a bending line or a trot fence. Points to follow horse.

Jr./Am Rider Division: Open to Jr./Am riders. Fence height 2'9" with oxers. Equitation over fences class must have one bending line and a trot fence. Riders may cross enter into low Jr/Am division. No cross entries into Green Rider or Stirrup divisions. Points follow horse/rider combination.

Baby Green Hunter Division: Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in the hunter division.

Green Hunter Division: Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in the hunter division.

Low Hunter Division: Open to horses and/or riders of any hunter level.

Modified Hunter Division: Open to horses and/or riders of any hunter level.

Medal Class Destinations

IEHJA Flat Medal: Open to all Jr./Am riders.

IEHJA 2'3" Medal: Open to all Jr./Am riders. Fences 2'3". Riders never to have won a medal finals at this height, or never to have won a class of 2'6" or higher.

IEHJA 2'6" Medal: Open to Jr./Am riders. Fences 2'6". Riders never to have won a medal finals at this height or have never won a class 2'9" or higher.

IEHJA 2'9" Medal: Open to Jr./Am riders. Fences 2'9". Riders never to have won a medal finals at this height or have never won a class 3'3" or higher.

Riders may not cross enter between the IEHJA Medal classes.

Jumper Classes "Winner Takes All" \$6 from each entry added back and awarded to the 1st place. Ribbons 2-6. Points to follow horse.

Beginner Jumpers (0.7m or 2'3"): Open to horses and/or rider in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in jumpers classes at any show.

Hopeful Jumpers (0.8 or 2'6"): Open to riders and/or horses that have not shown in any Jumper class higher than 2'9" at any horse show.

Modified Jumpers (0.9 m or 2'9"): Open to all riders and/or horses.

Pretraining Jumpers Division (0.9 m or 3'): Open to all riders and/or horses.
